## WHITE

### Château de L'Ou

#### 2021 Château de l'Ou Blanc (Organic)

50% Grenache Blanc, 40% Grenache Gris, 10%  
Roussanne  
AOP Côtes du Roussillon

Loved by wine critic Jeb Dunnick, this domaine is run by the husband-and-wife team, Séverine and Philippe Bourrier. Séverine studied oenology and worked in Bordeaux for a decade before becoming one of the finest female winemakers in the Roussillon. Philippe is the wise, earthy agronomist. Together, they restored an old château and rechristened the estate *L'Ou*, Catalan for "egg," a reference to the oval-shaped valley surrounding the estate. This stunning, organic cuvée has crisp notes of citrus and white fruit, making this delightfully dry cuvée the perfect, everyday white wine. A blend of rare Grenache Gris with Grenache Blanc and Roussanne, it refreshes and delights the palate. Its notes of citrus and white fruit enhance aperitifs and brighten the fresh flavors of grilled fish.

### Domaine La Coume-Lumet

#### 2019 Lo Camin Blanc (Terra Vitis)

50% Chardonnay, 50% Chenin Blanc  
AOP Limoux

The members of the family that own this domaine are skilled in a variety of backgrounds: computer science, mathematics, psychology and most importantly enology. This reservoir of knowledge was invaluable during the years the family spent studying and researching the region, and choosing the perfect vineyard. They formed La Coume Lumet in 2012. "La Coume Lumet" is the Occitan language and means "Valley of Light," a reference to the valley in which the vineyard is situated. The Terra Vitis certified vineyards are maintained using responsible viticulture. This white wine delights gourmets and casual sippers alike. Brioche and ripe pear aromas drift into an opulent finish. Serve this light-infused wine with chicken, fresh cheeses and sushi.

## ROSÉ

### Domaine Allegria - 2021 Dolce Farniente (Organic)

70% Grenache, 30% Syrah - AOP Languedoc

Created in 2008, Allegria is the result of a Franco-Argentinian friendship between the French Aboville family and the Argentinian Mota family of winemakers: on the one hand the passion and enthusiasm of a young family raising five children; on the other, one of Argentina's greatest oenologists, Roberto de la Mota, creator of Cheval des Andes and Bodega Mendel, recognized by all fans of Malbec. Syrah and Grenache give birth to this dashing rosé which enjoys great success year after year. On the nose, very nice aromas of fresh fruit, raspberry aromas. On the palate, it is tense and fresh with a nice balance. The finish is saline, almost salty. This is the rosé that will happily accompany your spring grills and your beautiful spring and summer evenings as an aperitif, or with salmon rolls, shrimp of any kind, grilled fish, or Pad Thai.

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# RED

## Les Maîtres Vignerons de Cascastel – 2018 Timon Lepidus

50% Merlot, 30% Syrah, 20% Grenache Noir – IGP Vallée du Paradis

The cooperative cellar of Les Maîtres Vignerons de Cascastel was founded in 1921. Before this collective initiative, the village of Cascastel was made up exclusively of independent winegrowers. Merging created a powerful synergy of expert winegrowers, wisdom, technology, and shared resources. As a result, these very small, artisan winegrowers bring out the best in the vines, the wines, and each other. They all benefit from the fine winemaking skills of José Navarro. Notes of ripe fruit and wood harmonize in this bold blend of Merlot, Syrah, and Grenache Noir. Firm tannins and a fine structure enhance the warming spiciness. The cooperative donates a portion of sales to protecting biodiversity, including rebuilding the stone wall habitat of the reptilian namesake of this stunning cuvée—Timon Lepidus. This dry red is brawny enough to handle Texas-style BBQ and grilled meats.

## Domaine La Rouviolle – 2020 Coup de Théâtre (Organic, Biodynamic)

100% Syrah – Vin de France

Over the past 60 years, Franck Leonor and his family completely renovated La Rouviolle, an old domaine in the prized appellation La Livinière, with the vineyards closest to the village of Siran. In a past life, Franck was an English teacher in Bordeaux. He loves to craft Bordeaux-style wines, but with the added benefit of the Mediterranean sun of the Languedoc. This wine is one of Franck's last vintages, as he retired and sold the domaine in 2022. A superb cuvée of depth and intensity. The nose is perfumed with black fruit, the palate powerful with ripe black currants, baking spices, truffle accents and an earthy grounding. The strong but ripe tannins harmonize with suave notes of prunes. Warm and eloquent, the finale of concentration draws a standing ovation. Wonderful with beef oxtail confit in red wine, beef bourguignon, and strong cheeses.
