## Domaine La Louviére 2021 Le Galant (Organic)

100% Chardonnay IGP Pays d'Oc

Winemaker Jem Harris moved to the Languedoc-Roussillon from Australia. He exemplifies the best of Old World terroir in the hands of a New World winemaker. Domaine La Louviére is owned by the famous Grohe family of designer bathroom hardware. Connoisseurs of quality, the Grohe family recognized the value of the terroir. Winner of multiple Silver and Gold medals in France and Vienna, including Gold at the Concours Général Agricole de Paris, this organic unoaked Chardonnay delights and surprises. Inviting aromas of tropical fruit, banana, and pineapple glide into a gentle, fresh finish. The "perfect gentleman," Le Galant is accommodating in structure and mouth feel with charming notes of brioche, nuts, and fig. The expressive fruit of this unoaked Chardonnay make it an exquisite companion to shellfish, coquilles St. Jacques, Thai chicken, and seafood.

## Domaine de L'Hortus 2021 Bergerie de L'Hortus Blanc (Organic)

30% Sauvignon Blanc, 30% Roussanne, 20% Viognier, 10% Chardonnay, 5% Petit Manseng, 5% Muscat IGP St. Guilhem Le Desert

Domaine de L'Hortus was established in 1978 when Jean Orliac, a professor of agriculture and avid rock climber, fell "head over heels" in love with the Languedoc region and purchased land around the beautiful Pic St Loup cliffs. After years spent befriending the vines and reviving 50 hectares of wooded slopes, Jean and his family bottled their first organic wine in 1990. They seduce us yet again with this crisp white blend. Light and lively, Bergerie Blanc lights up the glass with pale, shimmering gold. The smooth, balanced palate tantalizes with complex notes of fresh herbs, mint, white flowers, and citrus. The finesse and fullness of this cuvée make it an ideal aperitif, as well as a delicious companion to fish, shellfish, and cheese.

# Domaine Rouanet Montcélèbre - 2021 Se Canta Rosé (Organic)

100% Cinsault – IGP Pays d'Oc

Rouanet Montcélèbre is a family owned vineyard of 22 hectares (55 acres) located at the base of the Massif Central, in the Minervois appellation. Audrey Rouanet is the sixth generation in her family to farm the vineyards and make the family wines. She is an exceptional winemaker who studied in Tuscany and California. Audrey took over when her father was killed in a tragic work accident. Se Canta is a very old popular folk song that Audrey's father used to sing; she named this special wine in his honor. This crisp, dry rosé sings the song of the Cinsault grape grown at high altitude in white, rocky soils. A wine that sings of this terroir and sparkles with fresh strawberries, citrus and peach flavors in your glass. The minerality on the finish from the limestone soil can make you dream of the far away South of France. This aromatic rosé with lots of minerality is fantastic with charcuterie, grilled prawns and vegetables dipped in a lemon-mustard aioli.

#### Domaine Girard - 2020 Pech Calvel

100% Pinot Nori - IGP Pays d'Oc

Domaine Girard is a fourth-generation family domaine in the Malpere region just at the foothills of the Pyrenees Mountains where the vast grain fields begin. These brilliant winemakers were recommended by two of the finest winemakers in the Languedoc. We have thanked them ever since. Every wine created by this family domaine is delicious. Fill your glass with cherry-red Pech Calvel, a pure Pinot Noir from a fourth-generation family domaine high in the Pyrenees foothills. This quality cuvée opens with an earnest attack and raspberry and strawberry aromas. A perfect, elegant silky cherry mouthfeel touched by just a hint of oak. A delicious traditional take on a Pinot Noir of exceptional value. For a full-flavored, satisfying culinary experience, pair with Cuban Roast Pork with mashed sweet potatoes.

#### Domaine de La Réserve d'O - 2018 La Réserve Rouge (Organic)

45% Grenache, 45% Syrah, 10% Cinsault – AOP Terrasses du Larzac

Domaine de La Réserve d'O was founded in 2005 by the husband and wife team, Marie and Frederic Chauffray. Marie searched for 10 years before finding her perfect vineyards overlooking the Herault Valley in the prized Terrasses du Larzac appellation in the Languedoc. Today, on this windswept limestone ridge, Marie and Frederic produce organic, biodynamic wines which express the essence of this extraordinary terroir. 2017 La Réserve Rouge is the flagship wine for Domaine de La Réserve d'O. Grenache, Syrah and a touch of Cinsault give this organic, biodynamic cuvée a breathtaking, aromatic complexity and a silky mouthfeel. Rich black fruit of blackberries and cassis sparkle with hints of licorice and a dash of pepper. Soft tannins glide to a long, fresh finish. La Réserve Rouge adds gusto to grilled steaks and spiced pork chops with an onion and prune purée.
